Towering almost 100 feet above Watts, these structures were built by Simon Rodia from scraps of material found along the train tracks. More than three decades in the making, the towers are a testament to one man's vision, creativity, and ingenuity. The Watts Towers are now a State Historic Park and Community Arts Center.
